**Pupil Premium 2015-16**

The Pupil Premium grant is additional funding allocated by the government to the school, based on school census figures for pupils registered as eligible for Free School Meals. The grant is designed to benefit children from lower income families, and schools are required to make their own decisions about how to spend it to enhance the provision for their pupils. The purpose should be to improve pupils' experience of school, to motivate them to attend and participate, and to provide a curriculum closely tailored to their needs in order to improve progress and attainment.
