

## **Sports Premium 2015 -2016**

So far this year we have had allocations of £4,719 in December 2015. We are expecting an additional payment of approx. £5000 in April giving a total of approx. £9719

We have planned to spend this money on enhanced sporting activities for the children giving them experiences of activities which they may not normally have across the whole academic year.

Activities include Horse Riding (KS 1), Rock Climbing (KS2) and a modern dance instructor for all school children.

Transport to and extra staffing costs for inter school activities like orienteering, athletics, rounders, cricket and the Top-link festival will be paid to enable us to take part.

We have also hired the village hall enabling the children to have more space for dance and gym activities and remove the need for juggling classrooms and moving tables in school!

We purchased a new sports kit for all the children and staff giving them a smart, unified look without having to ask the parents for extra money.

We have paid our share of the Cluster PE support, this pays for a cluster organiser to co-ordinate sporting activities linked to the School Games timetable.
